#### **2021 Quilt Show Proposal**

The WOW Board proposes a 2921 quilt show to be held in the banquet room at the Maple Grove Community Center. This space is large enough to allow every member to enter one large quilt and one small quilt (45 inches wide). We are strongly considering holding our quilt show on October 8-9, from 9am to 4pm. We plan to include quilting demonstrations, two or three vendors, a silent auction, a small boutique, the raffle quilt, and a display of our 2020 Challenge Quilt competition. Rent for the space and pole and drape and the cost of advertising on the Community Center's electronic billboard will be only 50% of the cost of the 2019 quilt show.

The advantages of holding the quilt show in this space include great visibility to the public, a central Maple Grove location, and an affordable budget. The attendance at the 2019 Maple Grove Quilt Guild's show at this location was 452. The attendance at the 2019 WOW Quilt Guild's show at Beautiful Savior Church was 350. Since our membership is double that of the Maple Grove Quilt Guild, we can anticipate great attendance.

You will receive a survey this week concerning the quilt show and essential expenses for the quilt show. Please consider this proposal and respond to the survey.

### **Community Service:**

The Community Service group continues to look for a meeting site. We are looking for a meeting room where we could come together and work on community service projects for one day a month.
