Stars of Hope: the 2021 WOW Quilt Show

The WOW Board has approved the planning of the 2021 Quilt show. Hope for a better future is expressed by the WOW raffle quilt of stars and our quilt show theme: <u>STARS OF HOPE</u>. The quilt show is scheduled for October 16, from 9:00 am to 3:30 pm, in the Maple Grove Community Center.

The WOW Board has determined that WOW members and returning members who have paid the full membership fee of \$30 for 2021 may enter two quilts in the quilt show: one large quilt (over 60" wide) and one small quilt (under 60" wide). Members may register an additional quilt (to be selected by a drawing) to fill any available space. New members, who joined WOW after February, may enter 2 quilts, with no additional fee.

Registration of quilts for the show will be done online through Kevin. When you bring your quilt in for the show, you will receive a bar code on your iPhone. If you do not have an iPhone, you will receive a ticket that will allow you to retrieve your quilt after the show.

This year our quilts will be judged by the guests attending the show. Quilts will be hung according to the quilt categories below, and 1^{st} , 2^{nd} , and 3^{rd} places will be awarded in each quilt category.

- Machine pieced/paper pieced with professional longarm quilting
- Machine pieced/paper pieced with private quilting
- Hand pieced/English/hand quilted/ hand appliqued/embroidered
- Art Quilts
- Quilts with Machine Embroidery
- Miniature Quilts(first come first serve)
- Non-Judged
- Jr Member

Wow members will also vote to award overall 1st, 2nd, and 3rd prizes.

Judging of the quilts will be done electronically and on paper. .

Boutique: We encourage members to make high-quality items that will sell for less than \$25. Some examples are masks, children's toys, potholders, table runners, microwave bowls, and aprons. To register boutique items, members will complete a form that allows them to specify a minimum price to be charged for each of their items. They will be allowed to retrieve items that do not sell in the boutique.
